<u>Just so you know</u>: The kiosk is easy to use. To make it even easier, when you know guests are coming, give them your 4-digit code in advance. That way, when they pull up to the kiosk, all they have to do is hit the phone icon and key in your 4-digit code. The kiosk will call the number you gave the office to use. When your guest identifies themselves to you, just hit 1 on your phone, the call will end and the guest gate opens. It takes less than two minutes. If your guest does not know your key code and has to scroll to find your name, it will take longer. The kiosk system allows gate attendants to spend time with their family on holidays.


